TIMETABLE

Friday 20th June

- Camping Opens: 2:00pm
- Section Inspection: 5:00pm – 9:00pm only

Saturday 21st June

- Machine Examining: From 8:30am
- Signing On (Riders & Minders): From 8:30am
- Observers & Officials Briefing: 9:30am
- Riders Briefing: 9:45am
- First Rider Starts: 10:00am (Access to practice area allowed only after rider has started the event)
- Riders Start: At 1-minute intervals
- Time Limit: 5 hours 30 minutes per rider
- Results: Posted after trial with a 30-minute protest period

Note:

- Engines must not be started before a rider's designated start time. No practice is permitted before your own start time. Paddock must remain silent before the trial begins.

ROUTES & CLASSES

Course: 3 laps of 12 sections. Sections must be ridden in numerical order.

Start times and positions will be published at signing-on and Parc Ferme.

Trial4Y Debutant Boys – YELLOW (Route 4)

Trial4Y Debutant Girls – YELLOW (Route 4)

Trial3Y Foundation Boys – GREEN (Route 3)

Trial2Y Foundation Boys – BLUE (Route 2)

Trial2Y Foundation Girls – GREEN (Route 3)

TrialGBY Aspire Boys – RED (Route 1)

TrialGBY Aspire Girls - BLUE (Route 2)

CLASS DETAILS:

Each route includes separate classes for girls and boys (e.g., TrialGBY Aspire Girls / Boys).

Female riders will ride one class lower than their male counterparts.

Riders may compete in a lower class on a no points basis, in line with ACU TrialGB Youth Championship regulations.

ASSISTANTS / MINDERS

Each rider is allowed one assistant, aged 18 or over. Assistants must:

- Sign on and wear ID provided by the organisers
- Be on foot only – no bikes allowed (electric, petrol, or pedal)
- Only enter a section when their rider is next to ride
- Not touch the rider or machine in the section – this will incur a five-mark penalty

Poor behaviour by an assistant may lead to penalties or exclusion for the rider.

SAFETY NOTES

- All machines must use environmental mats when being refuelled.
- Use only the designated route between sections – no riding in reverse.
- Riders must ride at safe speeds & observe the site speed limits.
- The underpass is separated for riders and pedestrians. Stay left in your direction of travel and ride at walking pace.
- Dangerous riding or abusive behaviour will not be tolerated. Yellow cards and disqualification may apply.
- All rules fall under the ACU National Sporting Code and the TrialGB Youth Regulations.
